Origin, goals and donations of PAWA

The Pedro Arrupe World Association (**PAWA**) was created in **July 1986** at the Versailles world congress, in response to the message that was delivered by Fr. General Peter-Hans Kolvenbach, Superior General of the Society of Jesus: *“...It is my wish that you may further increase your actions and form for yourselves the instruments that will enable you to act...”*.

PAWA became **the WUJA’s social arm** following a decision taken at the 1997 world congress in Sydney (Australia), which enabled the association to launch the **“arrupe dollar”** campaign (in Europe, the **“arrupe euro”** campaign) on a yearly basis, to finance the PAWA’s charity programme.

PAWA has **the three goals** :

- **to promote and contribute to the commitments undertaken by alumni/ae** – and their associations – in favour of underprivileged persons ;
- **to develop and finance humanitarian and/or socio-educative programmes** in favour of **“the poor, refugees, and/or victims of natural calamity, violence or endemic diseases**, that have been set up by either alumni/ae, their associations, or by ad hoc services of the Society of Jesus” (e.g. Jesuit Refugee Service **JRS**, African Jesuit AIDS Network **AJAN**) ;
- **to help young Alumni/ae from developing countries** - or any other person, recommended to the World Union by their local associations or by their national federations which are members of the World Union - to participate in the world congresses.

➤ **Total donations (“Dollar Arrupe”) managed (1987-2021) : 420,000 USD.**
