Strengthening Bonds Regionally: Regional Confederations






Their energy, vision, and passion have the potential to reshape the world, and it's imperative that we empower them to do that.

This collaboration underscores the shared commitment of WUJA and Fe y Alegria to advance access to quality education for marginalized communities and as a direct response to Resolution #2, Francisco Guarner, President of WUJA, and Gabriel Calderón, President of UASIALAC, officially sealed the agreement.

This was a significant stride in the global mission of Jesuit Alumni.

With a particular focus on border regions, this pilot project aims to set a precedent for future collaborations, driving the mission of Jesuit alumni to promote quality education worldwide.

Building on a legacy of collaboration, the framework envisions an ad hoc commission dedicated to developing an institutional roadmap, projects, and volunteer initiatives, amplifying the global reach of education and positive change.


